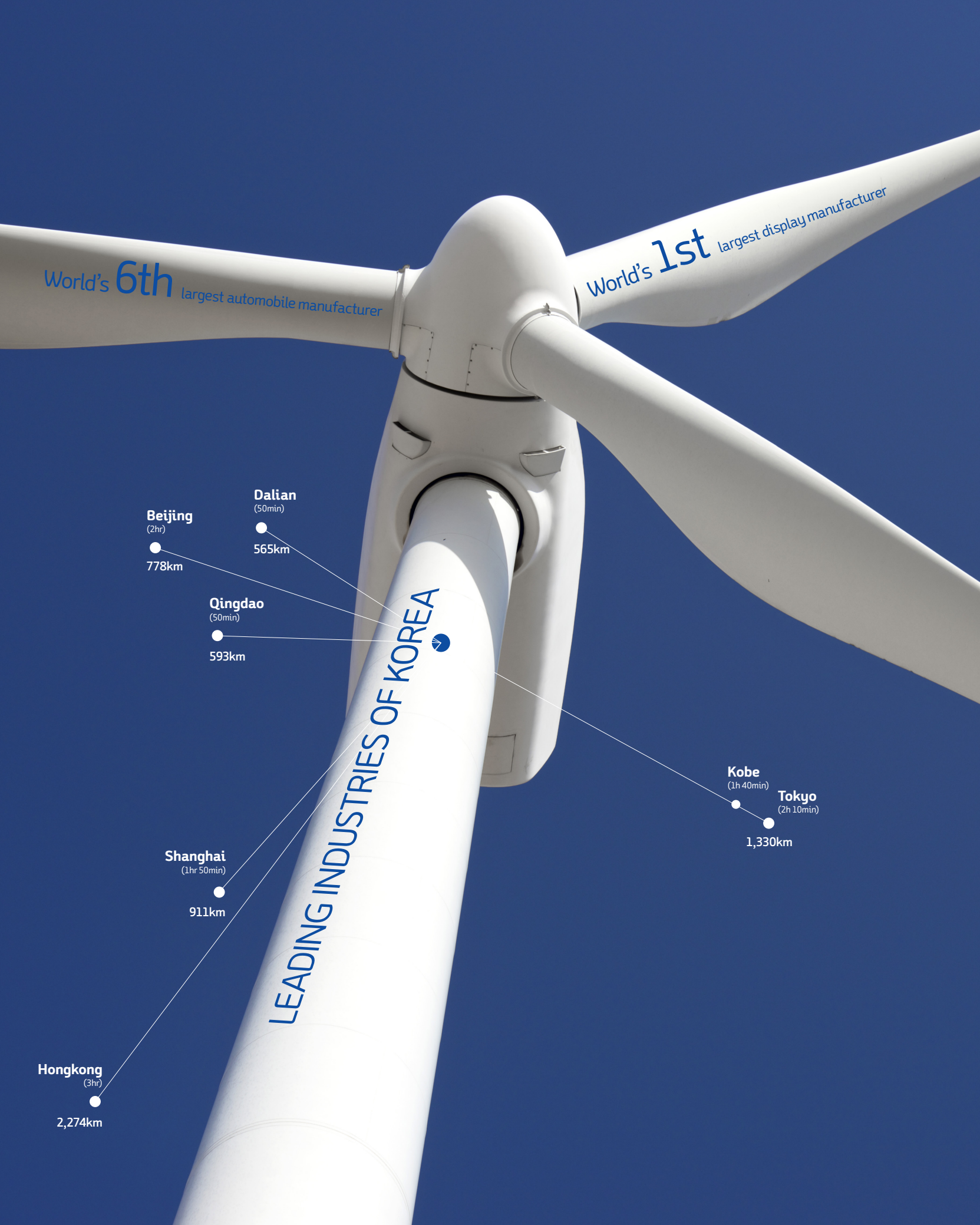

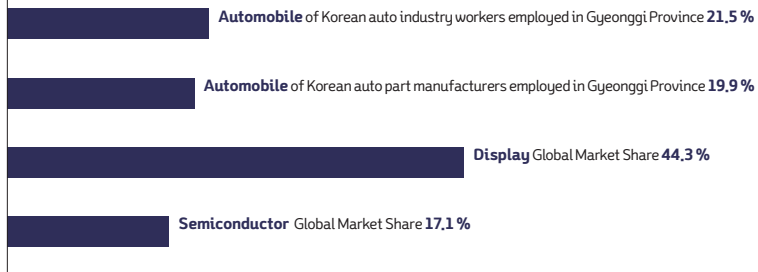

> A burgeoning logistics hub, Gyeonggi Province offers four main gateways to Korea: Incheon International Airport, Gimpo International Airport, Incheon Port, and Pyeongtaek Port (the nearest seaport to China). The province also boasts efficient road and rail networks, providing easy access to any part of Korea. In addition, the Uiwang ICD and Gunpo Cargo Terminal Complex, logistics hubs of the Metropolitan area and the surrounding areas, are open and fully operational.

Great Train Express (GTX)

To address traffic congestion and air pollution issues in the capital region, Gyeonggi Province is undertaking the construction of the Great Train Express (GTX).

Running at speeds up to 200km/hr, GTX will connect all areas of Seoul and Gyeonggi Province within a 30-minute travel time.

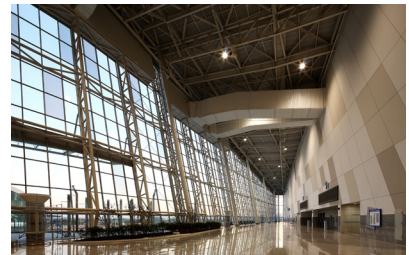

Building and expanding a global network is crucial for the success of a business today. Gyeonggi Province operates Gyeonggi Business Centers (GBCs) in core strategic markets around the world and works closely with corporations to explore new markets, effectively create new values, deal with issues associated with the market entry, and raise global competitiveness. With the recent opening of GBCs in Frankfurt of Germany and in Nairobi of Kenya, Gyeonggi now operates a total of thirteen GBCs around the world including Mumbai, Moscow, Kuala Lumpur, Los Angeles, Singapore, Tehran, Frankfurt, Nairobi, Shanghai, Shenyang, Guangzhou, Chongqing and Ho Chi Minh.



G-FAIR

KEY INVESTMENT INCENTIVES

Lease Benefits & Tax Exemptions

To satisfy the needs of foreign companies, industrial complexes have been made available exclusively for foreign-invested companies in strategic locations around the province. Eligible companies are offered very low rental rates of about one percent of the publicly listed rates. Foreign-invested companies operating in Gyeonggi Province are eligible for a 5-year reduction or exemption of tariffs and value-added tax as well as a 7 to 15-year reduction or exemption of local taxes including acquisition tax and property tax.

Tax Exemptions

Foreign-invested companies can also enjoy national tax exemptions (on corporate and income taxes) for up to five to seven years from the first year the company sees profit. Companies also receive local tax breaks (on acquisition and property taxes) for up to 10 to 15 years, in addition to exemptions from tariffs and VAT for five years.

Administrative Services

Gyeonggi Province also offers various services such as infrastructure and management support to improve the business environment for foreign-invested companies.

KEY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

Godeok International City

With the relocation of United States Forces Korea (USFK) headquarters from Seoul to Pyeongtaek City, more than USD 11 billion will be invested to transform the area into Godeok International City, an international center for business, technology and global exchange.

Korea International Exhibition Center (KINTEX)

KINTEX was established to serve as a trade facilitation venue for both leading local and overseas companies. The 1st stage of KINTEX opened in April 2005 with an indoor exhibition area of 55,000m² and the 2nd stage was completed in September 2011 with an additional 55,000m² of exhibition area. With a combined exhibition area of 110,000m², KINTEX is now the largest exhibition and convention center in Korea and the 4th largest in Asia.

Pyeongtaek Port Hinterland Complex

Pyeongtaek Port itself is the fastest growing port in Korea in terms of cargo volume, and it plans to expand its total berthing capacity from 62 ships to 79 ships by the year 2020. To support this expansion, the hinterland complex will feature an integrated logistics cluster. The three-stage development plan for this complex will see it expand to a total area of more than 5.5 million square meters by the year 2020.

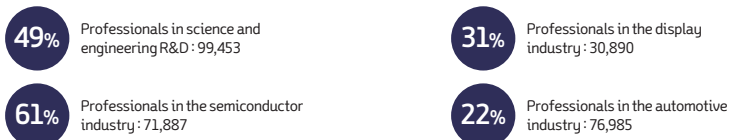

HEART OF INTER- KOREAN EXCHANGE

> **Korea** is the only divided nation in the world, and Gyeonggi Province is an immediate witness to this as it directly borders North Korea. Prior to the division of the Korean Peninsula, North Korean localities, such as Jangpung and Kaesong—where the Kaesong Industrial Complex is currently located—originally were part of Gyeonggi Province.

> **Accordingly**, the Gyeonggi Provincial Government is reaching out to North Korea including the former Gyeonggi regions so as to build and strengthen cooperative and mutually beneficial relations. In so doing, the Gyeonggi Provincial Government intends to contribute to peace and the unification of two Koreas.

ADVANCED INTER-KOREAN EXCHANGE SYSTEM ESTABLISHED

Among all of Korea's provincial governments, Gyeonggi is the only one that has a specialized department-level unit for inter-Korean exchanges. The province is undertaking a variety of projects for inter-Korean exchange and cooperation by securing some of the largest funding amounts among all provincial governments in the nation.

VARIETY OF HUMANITARIAN & MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL EXCHANGE PROJECTS

Gyeonggi Province is taking part in preventive measures against malaria in the inter-Korean border area and a project to support treatment for tuberculosis patients in North Korea (estimated to number approximately 1 million). The province has supported the modernization of farming villages as well as the establishment of hog farms and tree nurseries in order to help effectively improve quality of life North Korean residents instead of simply providing one-off support.

SOCIOCULTURAL & SPORTS EXCHANGES TO RECOVER NATIONAL HOMOGENEITY

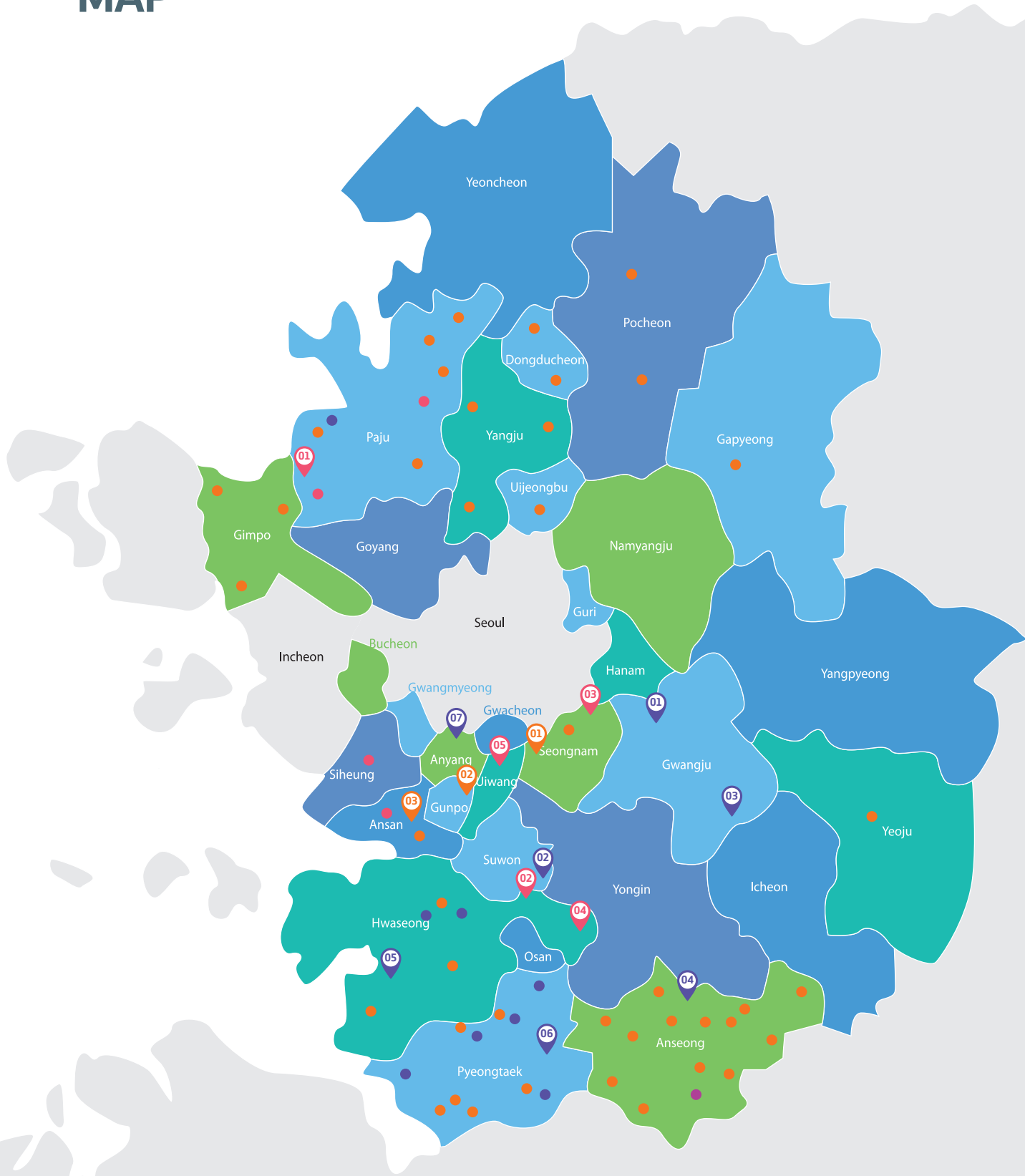
Gyeonggi Province supports a project to preserve Korean traditional houses located in the Kaesong Historical District (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) and a youth football tournament jointly held by South and North Korea. Through such efforts, the province is expanding the scope of inter-Korean exchanges to recover national homogeneity.

ESTABLISHING INTER-KOREAN EXCHANGE PARTNERSHIPS IN KOREA AND ABROAD

Gyeonggi Province continuously takes part in Korean and foreign partnerships to support North Korea, such as through international conferences attended by concerned organizations including the UN as well as NGOs from Korea and abroad. The province will continue to play a central role in inter-Korean exchanges through practical and efficient methods based on the principle of promoting the interests of the Korean peninsula as a whole.

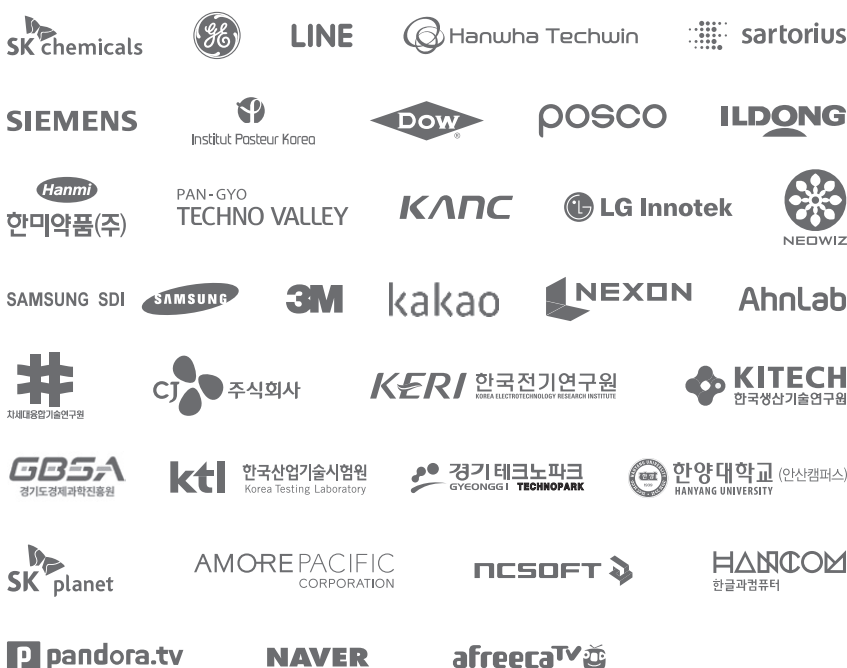

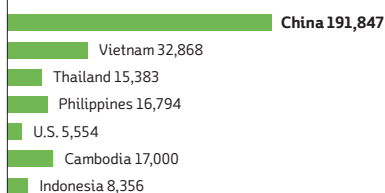

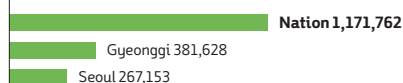
FOREIGN RESIDENT POPULATION OF GYEONGGI (2017.12)

HELPING FOREIGN RESIDENTS ADAPT TO LOCAL LIFE

- Operation of foreign migrant welfare centers in 7 areas (Suwon, Namyangju, Ansan, Siheung, Hwaseong, Gimpo, Seongnam): provision of counseling, legal aid and other administrative services
- 'Together Day' and Multicultural Week held every May for foreign residents
- Operation of support centers for immigrant spouses of Korean citizens in 31 locations: provision of Korean language training, family counseling and other services

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Designated a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site in 1997, Hwaseong Fortress is situated in Suwon City, the capital of Gyeonggi Province. The fortress was constructed in the 18th century by King Jeongjo of the Joseon Dynasty to honor his father, Prince Sado. Restored to its original splendor, the architecture of Hwaseong Fortress combines traditional Eastern and Western styles, which sets it apart from other contemporary military structures. Advanced military and engineering principles were also incorporated in the construction of this worldrenowned fortress.

NAMHANSANSEONG FORTRESS

Preserved in the memorial hall are many of King Sejong's personal belongings including a painting of Jiphyeonjeon-Haksado (a renowned Joseon Dynasty institution of learning founded by King Sejong).

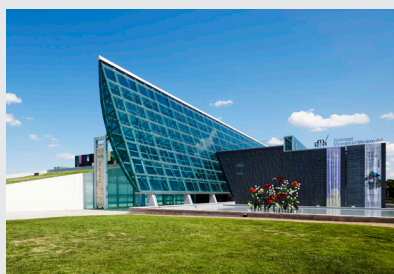

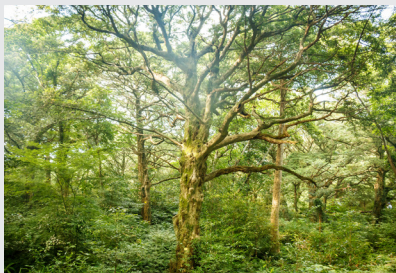

Silhak was a pioneering movement that arose amidst Westernization movements and the emergence of a commercial economy in the late Joseon Dynasty. It sought to rebuild Joseon society after it had been devastated by Japanese and Chinese invasions by emphasizing social and economic reforms, the advancement of commerce and industry, and technological development. Although cultural relics from this time are found in many places, most of the cultural relics related to Silhak can be found in Gyeonggi Province. Thus the Museum of SILHAK was established to preserve and promote this venerable area of study.

THE KOREA NATIONAL ARBORETUM (GWANGNEUNG FOREST)

The arboretum was created in an experimental forest in Gwangneung and contains a forest museum where information on forestry is exhibited. The arboretum covers an area of 1,157 ha and consists of 15 specialized forests including Conifer Garden, the Garden of Ornamental Trees, and the Garden for the Visually Impaired. The forest museum is the largest in Asia, covering 4,628 square meters, with a traditional design that follows the natural contours of the surrounding natural landscape. The interior and exterior are both constructed of domestically-produced wood and stone.

Dumulmeori, a popular filming location, literally means “two water area” and refers to the place where the Bukhangang River, flowing from Geumgangsan Mountain, and the Namhangang River, originating from Geomryeongso at the foot of Geumdaebong Peak in Gangwon Province, meet. The name translates as “兩水里” (yangsuri) in Chinese, it refers specifically to the area surrounding the dock for an ancient ferry in Yangsuri. It has become widely known as a popular site for shooting TV dramas and movies. The dense fog that rises from the river early in the morning, the dock associated with old movies, and weeping willows hanging over the river combine to create unique scenic beauty, making Dumulmeori a popular site taking wedding photos and filming movies, commercials, and TV dramas. The private property is also popular among amateur photographers. It is particularly famous for its beautiful snowy landscape and sunset.

HEYRI ART VALLEY IN PAJU

Heyri Art Valley is an art and culture district where culture, creative art, exhibitions, performances, festivals, and education come together. The unique name of the community came from the pure Korean words “heyri sori,” a traditional farmer’s song that farmers in the Paju area used to sing while working their fields. Various works of art scattered throughout the town harmonize with nature, making the entire area a giant work of art and ideal for family outings. The buildings in Heyri were designed and built according to the principles of not using paint and ensuring that all buildings are no more than three stories tall. A trip to Heyri begins by looking at these buildings. Around 60% of all the buildings in Heyri are open to the public as places for creative activities and cultural experiences. As seasons change, Heyri holds different cultural and art events where well-known cultural and art groups from Korea and abroad are invited or perform.

You can easily find volcanic rocks from past volcanic activity in the area surrounding the Hantangang River. These rocks are basaltic and are commonly called gombo (a face with chicken pox) rocks because they are covered in small holes that form from air bubbles when volcanic lava cools rapidly. The surrounding scenery of the Hantangang River area is truly breathtaking and is also the site of a famous amusement park. The Hantangang River Resort, located in the lower region of the Hantangang River, stretches along 1.5 kilometers of the river bank between the Sarang Bridge and the Hantan Bridge in Jeongok-ri, Yeoncheon County. The Hantangang River flows from Pyeonggang in North Korea, passes through Cheorwon, Pocheon, and Yeoncheon, and eventually joins the Imjingang River. The river features many scenic locales, including a large valley, the walls of which consist of many rare rocks. The Goseokjeong Pavilion, Sundam Valley, and other leisure facilities are located nearby upstream. After repeated damage to the local infrastructure due to flooding of Hantangang River, the area has been transformed into Hantangang River Resort. The resort, with the great views overlooking the Hantangang River, is a great place for rest for the whole family, maintaining campsites for cars and recreational vehicles, the dinosaur-themed Children's Character Park, Children's Transportation Land, a water park, an ecological pond, and a soccer field.

Opened in May of 1988, Seoulland consists of themed areas in a uniquely interesting layout, including World Square, Adventure Land, Fantasy Land, Future Land, and Samcheonri Hill. Individual themes are all combined and integrated under the grand theme of "re-creation." The opening of the subway line in 1994 made it easier for people to access Seoulland, and a growing number of people are visiting the amusement park as a one-day outing destination in connection with the zoo and the botanical garden within Seoul Grand Park nearby, the National Museum of Contemporary Art, and IT-World (an ultra high-speed IT pavilion). In addition, Seoulland is constantly evolving and transforming itself by introducing new rides and organizing performances and exhibitions, as well as by holding festivals of flowers including tulips, cherry blossoms, and chrysanthemums. Recently, the park launched a laser show during the evening opening season and is gaining popularity as a special place for fun and relaxation by taking advantage of the Rose Garden, the largest in scale in Korea. Seoulland plans to add more park facilities to grow into a full-scale leisure complex that people can visit to get away from their daily routine and recharge their batteries all year round.

The Garden of Morning Calm is a botanical arboretum set against the backdrop of the beautiful landscape of Chukryeong Mountain. The arboretum consists of gardens designed with different concepts, each of which uniquely depicts the traditional beauty of Korea in its way. Visitors can stroll in a dense forest of pine nut trees while enjoying different features of individual gardens. Scenic walkways, beautifully manicured lawns, and flower beds connect the garden's 20 different themed sections. Most popular among visitors is the Sunken Garden that is shaped like the Korean Peninsula and is carpeted with beautiful flowers. The garden houses about 5,000 kinds of plants, including 300 varieties native to Baekdusan Mountain. The garden is constantly attracting tourists as it is known as the filming location for numerous popular movies, TV shows, and documentaries including the Letter, Detective K, Obsession, My Golden Life, Let's Hold Hands Tightly and Watch the Sunset, Jugglers, Love of the Monarch, Black, School 2017, the King in Love, Introvert Boss, Moonlight Drawn by Clouds, Laugh, Donghae, You Are Beautiful, Infinite Challenge, and Documentaries of Success

Panmunjeom, which is a 90-minute drive away from Seoul, is a joint security area (JSA) located in the demilitarized zone (DMZ) in Jinseo-myeon of Paju City. On April 27, 2018, under the agenda of “Peace, a New Beginning”, South Korean President Moon Jae-in and North Korean leader Kim Jong-un of the State Affairs Commission held an inter-Korea summit in the truce village of Panmunjom, which resulted in the adoption of the “Panmunjeom Declaration for Peace, Prosperity and Unification of the Korean Peninsula”. It is a historically meaningful place where the two leaders worked out an agreement on improving South and North Korean relations including building a permanent framework for peace.

It has established itself as a forum where ceramic artists and enthusiasts from around the world gather to engage in the exchange of ceramic culture and explore global ceramic trends.

Icheon - Icheon Cerapia (where “Cerapia” is a portmanteau of “ceramics” and “utopia,” referring to a “utopia of ceramics”) is one of the main venues of the biennale and a true ceramics paradise. It is a global ceramic art park situated in Icheon, a city that has become famous for ceramic art in Korea. In order to stimulate greater appreciation for ceramic arts, everything at Icheon Cerapia is made from ceramics, including the galleries, the playground, the café, and even the bottom of the lake. The major facility of Icheon Cerapia is the Icheon World Ceramic Center (CeraMIX Creativity Center), which houses more than 2,000 modern ceramic artworks from around the world. The center is a cultural complex that allows visitors to appreciate and learn about world-renowned ceramic artworks through a variety of special exhibitions and provides residency programs, workshops, and hands-on experience facilities for artists, giving them an opportunity to focus on their creative activities. In particular, the CeraMIX Creativity Residency Studio, located on the first floor of the Icheon World Ceramic Center (CeraMIX Creativity Center), has become popular among visitors for its hosting of demonstrations by ceramic artists and glass artists showing off their glassblowing and lampworking skills.

Yeosu Dojasesang is located in Yeosu of Gyeonggi Province, a city that has become renowned for its production of ceramic livingware, which was made possible due to the abundance of clean water, lush pine forests, and quality kaolin clay in the area. Dojasesang is home to the World Ceramic Livingware Gallery (Bandal Art Museum), a livingware museum, and the largest ceramic shopping mall in Korea, consisting of four major shops-the Art Shop, Living Shop, Brand Shop, and Gallery Shop-organized according to the characteristics of the products and the tastes of customers. Located near numerous popular tourist attractions, including Riverside Park, Silleuksa Temple, the birthplace of Empress Myeongseong, Yeongneung Royal Tombs (tombs of King Sejong and Queen Socheon), the gallery is a cultural complex dedicated to ceramic livingware where visitors can browse, purchase, create, and appreciate various types of ceramicware.

With its main facilities including the Gyeonggi Ceramic Museum, which showcases major relics and artworks that date all the way from the birth of Korean ceramics to modern times, and Mosaic Park, which focuses on exhibiting public artworks, the Gonjam Ceramic Park is a multicultural complex where people can experience Korean traditions, culture, art, education, recreation, and relaxation through traditional handicraft workshops, hands-on classes, outdoor performances, a ceramics shopping mall, sculpture parks, and a gallery cafe, all of which operate year round.

CAMP GREAVES

Located in the Paju Civilian Control Zone just two kilometers from the DMZ Southern Limit Line, Camp Greaves was a US military base for fifty years, and thus contains a variety of American architectural styles from the 1950s-1990s. After the relocation in 2004 of the US military unit that was stationed here, ownership of the site was transferred to the Korean government in August 2007. Camp Greaves has been transformed into a zone of peace, ecology and culture. Various facilities, such as the U.S. Army officers' quarters, gym, and living quarters, remain intact, and the camp has been turned into a peace and security experience facility and culture creativity place for the general public, as it was recognized as a modern cultural asset with significant cultural value. Located less than two kilometers from the DMZ, Camp Greaves now houses the first youth hostel established within an area in the Paju Civilian Control Zone. An entire building that once comprised part of the U.S. officers' quarters was renovated to create the youth hostel, which is capable of accommodating up to 240 guests. Offices and a small performance hall can be found on the second floor of the building, guest rooms on the second and third floors, and an auditorium and cafeteria on the fourth floor. Camp Greaves offers various programs and activities for visitors of all age groups, such as the Security OX Game, mini jangseung (Korean totem pole) and sotdae (prayer pole)-making sessions with wishes for unification, a special forces training experience, camp playground, the DMZ Golden Bell Challenge quiz show, and much more.

GWANGMYEONG CAVE

Korea's top cave-based theme park, Gwangmyeong Cave is a mysterious cavern full of attractions and activities for visitors to enjoy, integrating culture and art with a former mine that once boasted gold, silver, and bronze reserves. Gwangmyeong Cave has over 20 different facilities for tourists, including Cave Aqua World, Gold Falls, Gold Road, Gold Palace, Haunted Cave, Cave Underground World, Underground Lake, the LED-illuminated Space of Light, the largest dragon structure in Korea, and Wine Cave, where visitors can sample various wines. On the weekends, black light performances provide a feast for the eyes, and visitors can forget the complex difficulties of their daily lives for a while and relax while strolling around the cave. Located between Incheon International Airport and the heart of Seoul, Gwangmyeong Cave is easily accessible by car or public transportation from major cities and counties in the greater Seoul area within about one hour.

PETITE FRANCE

Meaning "Little France," Petite France is a French-themed cultural village that offers visitors the rare opportunity to experience French culture in Korea. This small, peaceful rural French village was created in Gapyeong County of Gyeonggi Province, and opened in July 2008. Its main facilities include the Traditional French House, a replica of a 150-year-old French house that also serves as an exhibition hall; Saint-Exupery Memorial Hall, where visitors can glimpse the life and works of the author of *Le Petit Prince*; the Orgel House, which showcases a wide range of music boxes; a French culture gallery; and a photo zone, where visitors can have their picture taken wearing traditional French clothes. The park contains other facilities including observatories, water fountain squares, wooden playrooms, grand auditoriums, and small auditoriums, and accommodation facilities for large groups of students and adults. The park was used as a filming location for MBC's dramatic series *Beethoven Virus*, a popular TV show that was aired in September 2008.

The 2019 Korea International Boat Show will be held from May 9 to 12 at KINTEX (32,157 square meters) and Gimpo Ara Marina (25,400 square meters), spanning a total area of 57,457 square meters.

Held in the second exhibition hall of KINTEX in Goyang City, 200 game companies and 336 export companies joined the event, which presented various content including futuristic games (AR, VR), convergence and experience-type games, and other popular games (mobile, online, console, arcade, and board), under the theme, “Meet the Future of Games.” Concurrently, business meetings for exporters, game-related forums, and other events also took place during the event. People were able to experience, in virtual reality, what future life could be like in such areas as medical services, education, travel, and shopping, in a specially designed VR booth where VR was combined with robotic technology, games, and other activities to create fun experiences for visitors.

JARASUM JAZZ FESTIVAL

A Jazz Festival held on Jarasum Island in Gapyeong County every autumn, the Jarasum Jazz Festival began in 2004 with over 30 bands from 12 countries, including the U.S., Japan, Sweden, and Norway. Also known as the JJ Festival, this massive event is attended by over 100,000 people from Korea and abroad. Located on the Bukhan River, Jarasum Island used to be a relatively unknown location that was visited only occasionally by couples for short romantic getaways. However, when the Jarasum Jazz Festival was launched there, walking paths, fitness and recreational facilities, and green spaces were created alongside the river, turning the island into a popular tourist attraction. The Jarasum Jazz Festival provides an opportunity for people to meet renowned jazz musicians from around the world while also experiencing their music. Many residents of Gapyeong County also participate in the festival and its sideline events, showing their generosity and offering their hospitality to jazz lovers from all around the world.

YEONCHEON JEONGOK-RI PALEOLITHIC FESTIVAL

The Jeongok-ri Paleolithic Site in Yeoncheon County attracted a great deal of attention in the winter of 1978 when an American soldier who had been visiting a part of the amusement park near the Hantang River discovered stone relics on the ground. The Yeoncheon Jeongokri Paleolithic Festival—an “edu-tainment” festival based on the theme “The Breath of Jeongok-ri”—is held at the Paleolithic site in Yeoncheon County, which has become one of the most famous prehistoric sites in Korea. The festival provides visitors with entertaining and educational experiences related to Paleolithic and prehistoric cultures. The largest prehistoric cultural festival in the world, the Yeoncheon Jeongok-ri Paleolithic Festival offers events and programs that are representative of the county’s unique characteristics and have been designed especially for families, including: the International Prehistoric Exhibition and Jeongok-ri Archaeology Academy, where visitors can learn about prehistoric cultures around the world through hands-on experiences; Paleolithic performances and barbecue, which reenact the lives of the people who lived during the Paleolithic era; agricultural culture experience programs, which offer a taste of the culture of Yeoncheon; and the Yeoncheon Agricultural and Local Product Market.

ICHEON RICE CULTURAL FESTIVAL

In Icheon, rice is produced through eco-friendly agricultural practices using a very high-quality rice variety. According to documents from the Joseon Dynasty (written by Bok Seungjeong, the county magistrate of Icheon), King Sejong once stayed in Icheon after visiting the royal tomb of King Sejong and was surprised by the delicious taste of the rice.

From that day onward, Icheon rice was served at royal meals. Icheon’s high level of sunlight exposure and large temperature variations from day to night during the growing season are perfect for rice cultivation, while the balanced mixture of clay and sand and underground water rich in magnesium provide excellent nutrition for rice plants. The Icheon Rice Cultural Festival is a huge celebration of rice, the symbol of Icheon City and the rice harvest, and is attended by people from all over the country. The event provides a great opportunity for children and youth to experience traditional agriculture, while adults enjoy the feelings of nostalgia to which the festival gives rise. Visitors can also purchase Icheon rice at the festival at very affordable prices. The Icheon Rice Cultural Festival is held every year in late October in the Seolbong Park area.

YEOJU OGOKNARU FESTIVAL

The Yeosu Ogoknaru Festival is a festival that brings together agricultural produce, including rice, sweet potatoes, peanuts, and fruits, and various local specialties produced in Yeosu. The festival is held at Silleuksa Temple Resort, where the scene of the old pier that once existed in Yeosu has been recreated. The term “ogok” in the title refers to five types of rice (barley, beans, Indian millet, and foxtail millet that ripen and are harvested in November) and conveys the warmth and abundance of the festival. Various fun and informative programs are offered for visitors throughout the resort, and high-quality agricultural and local products from Yeosu are provided to visitors from urban areas.

Namsadang traveled around markets and towns during the late Joseon Dynasty and performed acrobatics, dances, and songs; they were the first groups of entertainers in Korea made up of professional performing artists. The Anseong Namsadang Baudeogi Festival began in 2001 as part of efforts to preserve and develop the artistic spirit of Baudeogi, a renowned traditional namsadang performer. In 2006, the festival was designated as an official event of the International Council of Organizations of Folklore Festivals and Folk Arts (CIOFF) and has become the international festival of traditional Korean culture that best preserves its uniquely Korean identity.

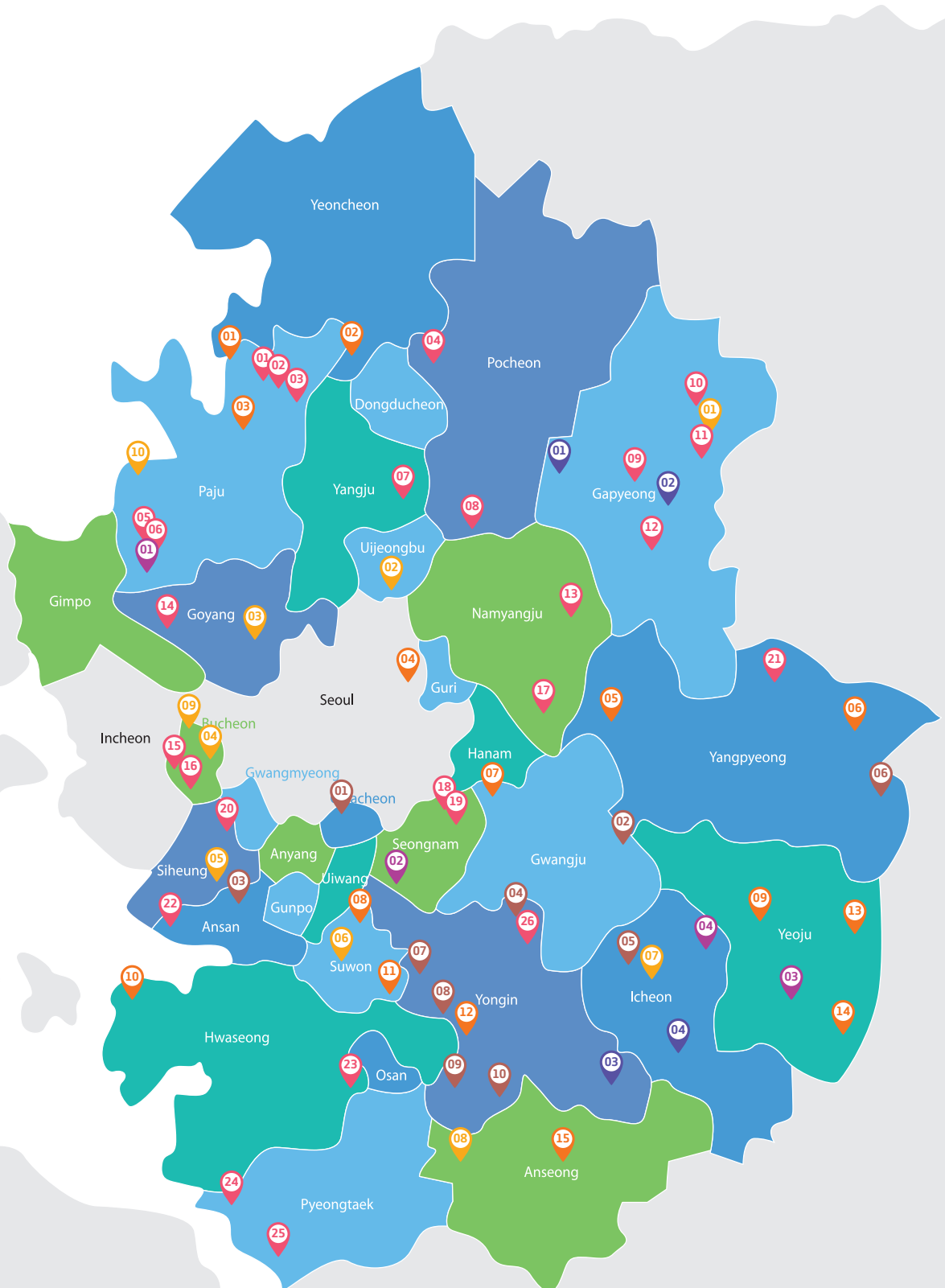
PAJU JANGDAN SOYBEAN FESTIVAL
